Please read this entire page before selecting a Permission Form.

For What Activities Does My Child/Youth Need a Permission Form?

Any Good Shepherd Lutheran Church sponsored children or youth event that is at a time and/or location other than regularly scheduled worship services, Sunday School classes, confirmation classes, or music programs requires that a Permission Form be completed and signed by the student's parent or guardian.

Which Permission Form Should I Use?

There are **two different types** of Forms:

- (1) <u>Annual Permission Form</u> (covers all Good Shepherd events from September 1, 2015 through August 31, 2016). This form should be completed once a year and updated throughout the year if any key information changes (such as allergies, insurance information, etc.).
- (2) <u>Single Event Permission Form</u>—If you do not wish to use the Annual Permission Form, or if your child is not a regular participant in Good Shepherd Church events, you may use a Single Event Permission Form. This form should be filled out **once per each event** that requires a Permission Form and may only be used for that one event.

What is the Purpose of the Permission Form?

Both forms allow children and youth to participate in a Good Shepherd sponsored event.

If a medical emergency occurs during the event, the forms also allow the leaders, volunteers, or adult chaperones of a Good Shepherd Church event to administer first aid and/or transport the individual to the nearest doctor or hospital for further medical attention. The Permission Form is for your child's safety! Without it, a doctor will not give them medical attention, unless the injury is immediately life threatening.

Additional Notes

Occasionally, an organization or facility (such as Campgaw for snow tubing) will require its own Release of Liability Form. Youth desiring to participate in an event that requires a specific permission form and/or release form must submit a completed form **before** they can participate. Good Shepherd Church will make those additional forms available as the events arise.
