Beloved of God,

It's already September! How did that happen? It's been a very full and very busy summer here at Good Shepherd and I'm sure it won't slow down at all this fall. I hope to see all those back, on September 8th, who have been away from worship all summer, when we return to three services from two, and Sunday Church School starts back up.

We'll be doing Confirmation orientation on Sept 9, 10, and 11<sup>th</sup>. WELCA is having their first meeting on September 3<sup>rd</sup>. The Men's Group has moved their breakfast to the second Saturday in September (September 14<sup>th</sup>) to avoid conflicting with our Confirmation retreat on Sept 20-22<sup>nd</sup> at Camp Ma-He-Tu. Speaking of Ma-He-Tu, volunteers are needed to help with that and there is a wine and cheese gathering planned for the adult chaperones who are going, and a games/fun night orientation for the junior chaperones. Our prayer shawl ministry has been meeting all summer and they continue in the fall on September 9<sup>th</sup>. There is Hot Dog Sunday, a Junior Recital by Robert Callan (see his letter for more information), the choir is starting up again on Sept 12<sup>th</sup>, and I'm probably forgetting things like committee meetings, the Boy Scouts, Bible Study, Adult Forums, Book Groups and more.

Good Shepherd is a busy place. It's the kind of place that needs you to be involved by finding something that happens here that you love and plug into. It's the kind of place that works only because everyone who is a part of our church community does what they can. I'm so grateful for everyone who lends a hand and heart here. People here are amazing! And I hope you will find a way to be a part of the ministry and mission of Good Shepherd—with a little bit of your time, your passion, your finances and your prayers (we need lots of these!).

However, let me clarify something. Good Shepherd's busy-ness has a way of adding to the busy-ness of our lives. I mean, even typing the list of all that is going on was enough to make me feel a little stressed. And that shouldn't be. When I ask you to find a way to plug in, I ask you to find a place where the needs of this community and your passion meet, so that what you do, what you participate in here at Good Shepherd, can feed your soul. The people who sing in the choir find that ministry to be life-giving. The people who connect with the Ma-He-Tu retreat find that weekend exhilarating (and exhausting, but a good exhausting). The people in the prayer shawl group love their opportunity to gather so often, they met all summer (their choice). This is what ministry should be about: a place not to just be busy, but a place to feed your soul and make the world better at the meantime.

This month, we will be hiring a Volunteer Coordinator. Actually, we might well have someone hired by the time you receive this! She (we haven't hired the person yet, but we didn't have any men apply) will be getting to know as many people as she can. She will be listening to your passions and finding ways for you to plug into the ministries of Good Shepherd (and maybe helping us to start new ministries based on what you are passionate about)—not to make you busier, but so you can connect at Good Shepherd and find ways to feed your soul. I hope you will take the time to get to know her and will be willing to take the risk to say yes when she asks.

Kate Bowler is a professor at Duke Divinity School. At thirty-five, everything in her life seems to point toward "blessing." She is thriving in her job, married to her high school sweetheart, and loves life with her newborn son.

Then she is diagnosed with stage IV colon cancer.

Kate is very sick, and no amount of positive thinking will shrink her tumors. What does it mean to die, she wonders, in a society that insists everything happens for a reason? Kate is stripped of this certainty only to discover that without it, life is hard, but also beautiful in a way it never has been before.

"A meditation on sense-making when there's no sense to be made, on letting go when we can't hold on, and on being unafraid even when we're terrified. And it happens to be hilarious.
