Beloved of God,

As we begin the new church year, rolling into the month of December, I just want to tell you what is happening.

First of all, we're back online only for worship. We (the council and I) felt that it was the smart choice, given the increase in numbers of COVID infections, and given how hard we have worked over the last six months to be able to be open and safe. We would absolutely hate to have someone get sick now, especially with the promising news of vaccines being just on the horizon. We anticipate this "online only" being the case into January, and we will reevaluate then.

Of course, we still want to meet together. In person. As we can. So, the second Sunday of the month, we will have our drive-up service. I encourage you to come to that. I know it is a little different, but it's a great way to get to see each other safely.

Also, for Christmas Eve, we are planning (as long as the state isn't in lock-down or something) to be able to gather outside at 4:30 and 8:00pm for Carols and Communion. The service will be short. We'll gather outside our vehicles with burn barrels to keep us warm (and we'll have parking for those who want to stay in their cars too) and sing carols together, hear the Christmas story, and receive communion. A Christmas reflection from me will be available online. At 10:00pm, we will livestream (rather than pre-record) a traditional Christmas Eve service that you will be able to watch online and receive communion.

CREATIVE PLAY PRE-SCHOOL

The rest of our services this season will be either pre-recorded or entirely online. Sunday worship and Wednesday evenings (Holden Evening Prayer) will be premiered on our YouTube channel so that we can at least say "hi" to each other on the chat feed. There is morning prayer on Monday, a centering prayer led by Tim Chew via Zoom on Tuesday mornings, and Compline on Thursday nights. Also, we'll do Zoom coffee hours so we can check in. There will also be a Christmas Day service of Lessons and Carols that I encourage you to watch together next to your Christmas tree (or Christmas poinsettia, or over your Christmas coffee).

Good Shepherd's Sanctuary is particularly beautiful during Christmas time and so to allow time to come and pray in the space (or simply to sit and be), with all the greens, the Sanctuary will be open on December 15, 17, 21, 22, and 23 from 4-7pm for you to stop by and pray. There will be prayer sheets available for you to use and take with you as you like. This will be in addition to usual prayer times.

I hope most of you know that Good Shepherd receives the majority of its financial contributions during December. Not meeting together is a rough choice for us financially even though it is clearly the best choice to keep everyone as safe as possible and care for our community so that fewer gatherings allow institutions like schools to remain open longer. I hope that you will consider being generous with the congregation at this time. I have never found this community to not be generous and you always open your hearts to the needs around you. Normally, we have a full page of giving opportunities during this time of year, but with so many fewer opportunities because of COVID restrictions, I ask you consider your own congregation. It will make a difference for how we will be able to do ministry going into our future. It will ensure we can continue to be a community that gives generously. It will allow us to live up to who we want to be as a congregation that welcomes everyone.

I am praying that this season of Advent, a season of hope and longing for a better world, will help us see a true hope dawning in each of our lives in new ways. I am also praying for the health and safety of so many—for those who serve as doctors, nurses, police officers, firefighters, EMTs. For those who are trying to make small businesses (and larger businesses) work in this difficult economic time. For those who are struggling to make ends meet. Know you are in my prayers.
