





Magnolia Meals

Magnolia Meals at Home is a meal delivery program that provides nourishing meals to households affected by cancer, so that loved ones can spend quality time together. We have partnered with St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Teaneck, Magnolla and Trinity Lutheran in Bogota, to transport Magnolia Meals from Meals on Wheels in Nanuet, and bring them to St. Paul's. From there, they will be meals at home delivered to those undergoing cancer treatment.

<u>Telephone Reassurance Program</u> Meals On Wheels Meals are just our first course!

Meals on Wheels launched an initiative called the Telephone Reassurance Program, which provides older adults who live alone, or who have limited ability to leave their homes, with regularly scheduled telephone calls. The goal is to alleviate feelings of isolation among our seniors. We are looking for volunteers to regularly call and check in on the health and well-being of our seniors. You will be assigned contacts to make calls once a week, or once every other week, depending on the client. The last step is to complete a response form. Applications for the new school year 2022-2023, will be available in the school office beginning January 18, 2022.

If you would like to register your child for a program for the next school year please stop by the office to pick up an application. In order to best assure placement in your preferred class, please apply by January 28, 2022. After this date we open up enrollment to new members.

For the 2022-2023 school year the following classes will be available to your family providing we have the minimum enrollment required to proceed with each of the classes:

- Time for Two Classes (call for available days)

- 2 day 3 year old classes (2.5 hours, 9:30am 12:00pm)
- 3 day 3 year old class (3 hours, 9:00am 12:00pm)
- 3 day 3 year old class (2.5 hours, 1:00pm 3:30pm)
- 3 day 4 year old class (2.5 hours, 9:30am 12:00pm)
- 5 day 4 year old classes (3 hours, 9:00am 12:00pm)
- Creative Creations, Enrichment afternoon classes

For the school year 2022-2023 we are again making available to all families an "opt out" choice. By selecting this "opt out" choice, you will pay a pre determined amount, to cover some or all your workdays in the classroom. The office will arrange to have your work days covered after speaking with you and determining your needs. We understand many families who would love to attend Creative Play, but due to work and other obligations cannot participate in the cooperative workdays.

We have traditionally relied on families to help share the information regarding our school, we would appreciate you continuing to help us by sharing the above information with family and friends. While our classrooms will continue to reflect our mission of play with a purpose, we are excited to incorporate some new opportunities as well!
