From Pastor Mossl...

Dear Friends in Christ,

It was nice to be with you at your annual congregational meeting November 24. As you know, I am your coverage pastor until an interim pastor is named. I am currently pastor of Christ Lutheran Church, Newburgh, and have been since 2005. As Good Shepherd's coverage pastor, I hold office hours, visit the sick and homebound, and attend church council meetings. To be with you on the Lord's day and meet more of you was a real pleasure and I thank you for welcoming me from the day I started on September 1.

As you heard at the annual meeting, it is ours to care for the church through regular worship, giving, and helping with mission. A congregation has a two-fold nature: our internal community, and being Christ's people in our neighborhoods. Without a sense of mission, connections between us will atrophy; and neglecting internal community means the same. Just as Christ has two natures, truly divine and truly human, so the church has a dual purpose. Focusing on both is required.

I speak to you theologically because as congregations feel anxiety and have questions about the future, the tendency is to pull back in certain areas. True, some things prove to be low priority and can take a back seat for now. But community and mission cannot.

Our risen Christ is continuing to call Good Shepherd to maintain its connections and its mission. You are needed in Pearl River for a simple but profound reason: people need hope! As followers of Christ, our mission is to speak hope those inside our church and in our neighborhoods. As we do that, we hold on to the promise Jesus makes us, *I am with you always, to the end of the age,* Matthew 28.
