Dear Friends in Christ,

A brief update regarding the status of our transition. This past Sunday we heard from Ephesians 1 that Christ is the head of the church. As such, we are a living faith organism and we are responsible for the ensuring its health. The transition phase strives to make the body of Christ effective in its mission to continue to bring the hope of the gospel to the world.

A total of 87 members completed the Congregational Assessment Tool, the online survey that asked many questions about how we see ourselves as disciples and where we wish to go. Thank you to everyone who took the survey, we appreciate your time.

The next steps involve receiving a report and analysis back from the consultant. The Transition Team is in the process of scheduling a review of the data with a trained interpreter. That meeting will be for the Church Council and Transition team. Once we get a clear view of what the survey results are telling us, we will provide feedback to congregation. We hope the meeting with the analyst will be at the end of November, and have a general report to the congregation in December.

As we prepare for Thanksgiving, I give thanks for all of you. We have much work to do, but Christ has blessed us with many good leaders who are dedicated to our church.

Thank you, everyone, for your prayers for Theresa. She and I thank Jesus for all of you. It is a true blessing to have a community, and you are ours.


Men's Group Monthly Breakfast




